

# Introduction Nune



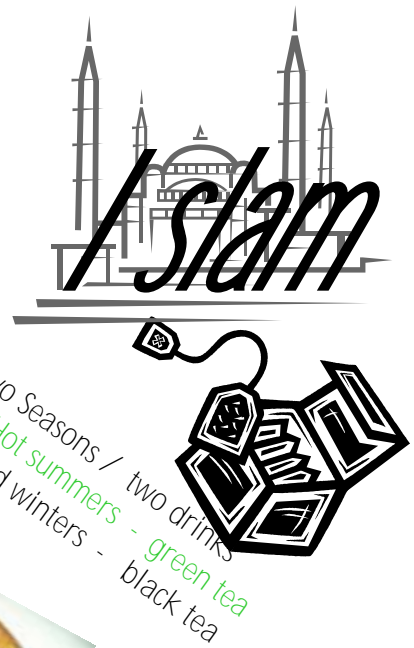

# Children's Story

## Food for the Nune People

Most of the Nune people are really poor. They live in small houses and usually share beds with their whole family in one room. In the winter, some people are so poor that they must decide whether to pay for coal to heat their home or pay for food to feed their family. This is a very hard choice for many people. What would you think if all of your family slept in the same room in the same bed? What would you give up-heat or food?

The missionaries in this area realized that God wanted them to help the Nune people in more than one way. Not only are the missionaries there to tell people about God's love and what Jesus did for them, but they are also there to help people with their physical needs. To do this, the missionaries decided to give people food –not just a little food, a LOT of food! It was clear that God really wanted them to do this.

So preparations were started. It took months to get everything lined up, and to get all of the help that they needed. They made jam, salads, and canned goods. They bought flour, sugar, oil, carrots, onions, potatoes – everything that a whole family would need to make their own traditional meals. They bought food and canned goods to give 8 families enough food to last all winter!

The day finally came when the missionaries were to deliver all of the food. Now, in the country that they are in, it is illegal to tell people about what Jesus has done for them, and it is illegal to give out religious books. The missionaries in this country had a whole bunch of Bibles in the Nune language, and really felt that God wanted them to give them away with the food. So they wrapped up the Bibles in special paper, and gave each family a Bible. The missionaries are still praying that the families will read the Bible, and believe in Jesus.

One poor old woman was living alone. She believed in God and prayed to Him every day. She had run out of rice and didn't have any money. She was so old that she couldn't work to get more money. So she prayed. She prayed that God would somehow send her some food, or give her a way to get food. She prayed, and then waited. The next day, a big truck showed up in front of her house. When she went out to meet the truck and see who it was, there was the missionary – with a whole truckload of food! God had heard her prayers and blessed her! Now she had food for the whole winter.

God heard the cry of this old woman, and answered her prayer. What joy that the missionaries felt to know that God had used them in this way!!!

# Memory Verse

Galatians 6:7

*Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows*

Explain what the hard words mean:

**Deceived: don't be tricked**

Mocked: God cannot be fooled, or made fun of

Supplies needed: a small box, shoe-box size or smaller (cut a hole in the top.), a piece of cord or string, small slips of paper with one word of the verse on each.

Directions: Attach these slips of paper on the cord at about 4 inch intervals, attaching the very first slip of paper about 6 inches from the end of the cord. Stuff the cord with the attached paper slips into the box with the beginning end hanging out. Begin by going over the verse and the reference. When they understand what the verse means, select a child to start pulling on the cord. This child pulls on the cord until he/she pulls out a slip of paper. He/she reads the word and then tries to guess the next word that will come out of the hole. After he/she guesses, let the child pull and see if he/she was right. If it was the correct word, the child may guess the next word and keep pulling until that child misses. Then the cord is handed to the next person to guess and pull. Very soon all the children will have learned the verse. This could be done with teams using different verses. Or, instead of Bible verses write questions on the slips of paper. If they answer correctly, he or she gets to pull another question.

**During the process the kids have learned God's Word.**

# Bible Lesson

## Planting Seeds for the Master

Read Galatians 6:6-10

Have you ever planted a seed? If you planted a bean seed, what would grow? Beans! If you planted a mango seed, what would grow? A mango tree! If you planted a sunflower seed, what would grow? More sunflowers! If you plant a certain kind of seed that is what will grow. God made the world this way.

People are the same as seeds.

Have you ever been angry with a baby brother or sister and spoke badly to them?

Have you ever not studied for a test, and then copied the answers from another student?

Have you ever been selfish and not shared with a friend?

- **If we have bad thoughts and attitudes in our hearts, then bad actions will “grow” out of our lives.**

But, have you ever seen somebody in need, and helped them? (Allow for responses)

Have you ever found something that was lost and returned it to the owner? (responses)

Have you ever helped your mom or dad without being asked? (responses)

- **If we have good thoughts and attitudes in our hearts, then good actions will “grow” out of our lives.**

As Christians, we need to do good things because they make God happy and we are obeying Him. He knows what is best for us. He promises to always be with us and help us.

Everyone has bad thoughts and does bad things sometimes. But what happens? Usually, a teacher or a parent finds out and then there is a punishment. But, do you know other children **who seem to always do bad things, but never get punished? It doesn't seem fair, does it?**

Does God see them? Does God see the bad things they are doing when no one else does?

Galatians 6:7 says that God will not be mocked. That means that we cannot make fun of God.

Some people think that if no one sees the bad things they do, then God does not see them either. Our Bible verse says that is not true. God sees everything. He will punish for bad actions; and He will be pleased by good actions.

**Isn't it good to know that God sees everything? Let's keep on 'growing' and do what pleases God.**

### Chinese Jump Rope

A Chinese jump rope is just a long circle, you can use a rope or elastic- so there is no beginning or end. Two kids will put it around their feet and stand far apart. So there are two strings that the "playing" child must jump over. They have create different patterns as they learn to jump over the ropes, and if they do the patterns wrong then they are out, and a new child gets to try. A pattern could be developed for use with repeating the memory verse. Each word would have a movement. One foot in, one foot out, both feet in, both feet out. You can also include movements to right and left of ropes.

### Or Bowling Rocks

The bowling rocks would probably be a better game to teach the kids. The reason it is so great is because you simply find whatever you can on the street- scraps of wood, empty bottles, etc. Ask the children to find different things that could be knocked over, then line them up at different angles to see how many they can knock over. They can take turns to see who can knock the most over, and move the items to different angles to make the game more interesting.
